The Championship consists of six main categories - Boys U10, Girls U10, Boys U14, Girls U14, Boys U18, Girls U18.

Participants will have 90 minutes to solve 8 compositions (3 two-movers, 3 Three-movers and 2 endgame studies). Each solved composition will be scored with five-point scoring system. The winning places will be determined according to accumulated points. In case of an equal score, the time spent is taken into account.
